Day 1: Arrival - Trier

Individual arrival to the oldest city of Germany. Allow the last 2000 years to pass by in a time lapse during a city round trip and discover world-known attractions. In the evening, you can enjoy the unique Riesling wine in one of the traditional wine taverns in Trier, as well as the atmosphere which is steeped in history.

Day 2: Trier - Trittenheim | Approx. 23 miles / 27km

Today, the route leads you on the bank of the Moselle through tranquil wine villages. From Trittenheim, you can reach the other riverbank by crossing one of the oldest bridges and view the old, preserved ferry towers. You can enjoy a wonderful view over the Moselle valley from the vineyards above the village.

Day 3: Trittenheim - Bernkastel-Kues/Zeltingen | Approx. 17 - 22 miles / 27 - 35 km

Passing the oldest wine village in Germany, Neumagen-Dhron, you arrive at Piesport, where an impressively restored roman cellar, dating back to the 4th century, awaits you. It is worthwhile to take a side-trip to the famous wine village Bernkastel-Kues and visit the paved market square, which is surrounded by half-timbered houses. Zeltingen displays a number of grand baroque buildings in Moselle tradition.

Day 4: Bernkastel-Kues/Zeltingen - Zell | Approx. 21 - 25 miles / 33- 40 km

Countless wine slopes are a cheer to the heart, inviting you to take part in a wine-tasting in one of the traditional taverns. After passing Traben-Trarbach, you will arrive at the Moselle loop in Zell, called the "Zeller Hamm". The Marienburg castle, around 900 years old, sits enthroned on the mountain ridge.

Day 5: Zell - Treis-Karden | Approx. 29 miles / 47 km

Enjoy a wonderful view on Europe's steepest vineyard, the Calmont. You have a spectacular view over the Moselle valley from the peak. You will arrive in Cochem, known for its imposing fortress complexes as well as for the Reichsburg castle, a landmark of german castle romance.

Day 6: Treis-Karden - Koblenz | Approx. 24 miles / 38km

In Moselkern, it is worthwhile to take a small detour to the nearby Burg Eltz (castle). The Moselle mouths into the Rhine by Koblenz. A splendid panorama view awaits you, when taking the cable car up to the Ehrenbreitstein fortress (incl.).


Day 7: Koblenz - departure

• Trier: Hotel Park Plaza **** S

In addition to its central location, the Hotel Park Plaza Trier is characterized by the combination of the Roman history of Trier in the form of Roman-ancient elements and modern design throughout the hotel.

• Piesport: Weinhotel Piesporter Goldtröpfchen ***

This 3-star hotel in Trittenheim offers cozy accommodation and a selection of wines from its own vineyards. The property is located on the Moselle between the historic city of Trier and the medieval Bernkastel-Kues. The rooms of the Hotel Galerie Riesling are tastefully furnished and some have their own terrace or balcony.

• Zeltingen: Weinhotel St. Stephanus ****

The traditional, family-run hotel in a classicist manor house with a modern outbuilding is located on the Moselle. It is 6 km from the Graacher Tor, a city gate built in the Middle Ages in Bernkastel-Kues, and 7 km from the Cusanus pen with its library and the wine museum.

• Zell: Hotel Schloss Zell ***

The small medieval town of Zell, which was founded in Roman times, is in a idyllic location on the Moselle. In the middle of the village is the former castle of the Elector Baldwin von Trier, where Emperor Maximilian stayed in 1571 and Friedrich Wilhelm IV, King of Prussia in 1847. Today the Hotel Schloss Zell accommodates guests from all over the world. Typical of the Hotel Schloss Zell is the combination of history and modernity, which together with the location results in a very special romantic flair. Look forward to an elegant ambience and modern comfort in your room.

• Treis-Karden: Schloss-Hotel Petry ****

All rooms and suites in the hotel create an elegant and friendly atmosphere with stylish colors, generous cuts and comfortable furnishings. You can also look forward to a new, 300 m² wellness area with a sauna area and steam bath.
