Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival - Trier

Arrive at your leisure to Trier, the oldest city in Germany, where history comes alive at every turn. Embark on a captivating city tour that spans over 2000 years of rich heritage and cultural significance. From ancient Roman ruins to medieval marvels, Trier boasts world-renowned attractions that offer a glimpse into its storied past. Marvel at the iconic Porta Nigra, an imposing Roman gate that stands as a testament to the city's ancient origins. Explore the grandeur of the Imperial Baths, once the largest Roman baths outside of Rome itself. Admire the intricate mosaics and well-preserved artifacts at the UNESCO-listed Roman Villa of Trier. Delve into the spiritual heritage of the city at the Trier Cathedral, a stunning example of Romanesque architecture housing the revered Holy Tunic, believed to be the robe worn by Jesus Christ during his crucifixion. Day 2: Trier - Trittenheim | Approx. 23 miles / 27km

Today, your journey takes you along the banks of the Moselle River, winding through serene wine villages. Starting from Trittenheim, you'll have the opportunity to traverse one of the oldest bridges, offering a glimpse of the well-preserved ferry towers on the opposite riverbank. As you ascend through the vineyards overlooking the village, be prepared to savor a breathtaking vista of the picturesque Moselle valley below.

Day 3: Trittenheim - Bernkastel-Kues/Zeltingen | Approx. 17 - 22 miles / 27 - 35 km

Continuing your journey, you'll pass through Neumagen-Dhron, renowned as the oldest wine village in Germany, before reaching Piesport. Here, a remarkable sight awaits: an impeccably restored Roman cellar dating back to the 4th century. Consider taking a detour to the renowned wine village of Bernkastel-Kues, where you can explore the charming paved market square surrounded by quaint half-timbered houses. As you move on to Zeltingen, you'll encounter a collection of magnificent baroque buildings, steeped in Moselle tradition, adding to the region's rich architectural tapestry.

Day 4: Bernkastel-Kues/Zeltingen - Zell | Approx. 21 - 25 miles / 33- 40 km

The rolling wine slopes beckon, promising a delightful experience of wine-tasting in one of the region's traditional taverns. As you journey past Traben-Trarbach, you'll soon reach the captivating Moselle loop in Zell, known as the "Zeller Hamm." Here, nestled amidst this natural wonder, sits the venerable Marienburg

As you continue your journey, you'll eventually reach Koblenz, where the Moselle River converges with the Rhine. Here, an unforgettable experience awaits atop the Ehrenbreitstein fortress. Take a ride on the cable car for a panoramic view that stretches as far as the eye can see, showcasing the beauty of the surrounding landscape in all its glory.

Day 7: Koblenz - departure

- **Trier:** [Hotel Park Plaza **** S](#)

In addition to its central location, the Hotel Park Plaza Trier is characterized by the combination of the Roman history of Trier in the form of Roman-ancient elements and modern design throughout the hotel.

- **Piesport:** [Weinhotel Piesporter Goldtröpfchen ***](#)

This 3-star hotel in Trittenheim offers cozy accommodation and a selection of wines from its own vineyards. The property is located on the Moselle between the historic city of Trier and the medieval Bernkastel-Kues. The rooms of the Hotel Galerie Riesling are tastefully furnished and some have their own terrace or balcony.

The traditional, family-run hotel in a classicist manor house with a modern outbuilding is located on the Moselle. It is 6 km from the Graacher Tor, a city gate built in the Middle Ages in Bernkastel-Kues, and 7 km from the Cusanus pen with its library and the wine museum.

The small medieval town of Zell, which was founded in Roman times, is in a idyllic location on the Moselle. In the middle of the village is the former castle of the Elector Baldwin von Trier, where Emperor Maximilian stayed in 1571 and Friedrich Wilhelm IV, King of Prussia in 1847. Today the Hotel Schloss Zell accommodates guests from all over the world. Typical of the Hotel Schloss Zell is the combination of history and modernity, which together with the location results in a very special romantic flair. Look forward to an elegant ambience and modern comfort in your room.
